WEBINAR DESCRIPTION

This PASERVIC webinar-workshop will establish and expand upon the ethical need for clinical competency in navigating religion and spirituality in counseling. The presenters will define religious and spiritual competency with reference to the ASERVIC competencies and connect these competencies to the ACA code of ethics and PA law. Attendees will also have an opportunity to explore related elements of countertransference utilizing a training tool, reflect on cases relating to the ethical inclusion of religion and spirituality in counseling, and practice implementing such ethical considerations via small group work.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Participants will be able to define religious and spiritual competency in order to attend to those dimensions of counseling in an ethical manner.
2. Participants will recognize the ASERVIC Religious and Spiritual Competencies and identify the ethical rationale for attending to them in clinical practice and counselor education.
3. Participants will compare the Competencies with the ACA Code of Ethics (2014) and PA Licensure law.
4. Participants will explore countertransference content related to their values and practice ethically implementing interventions within clinical cases.
