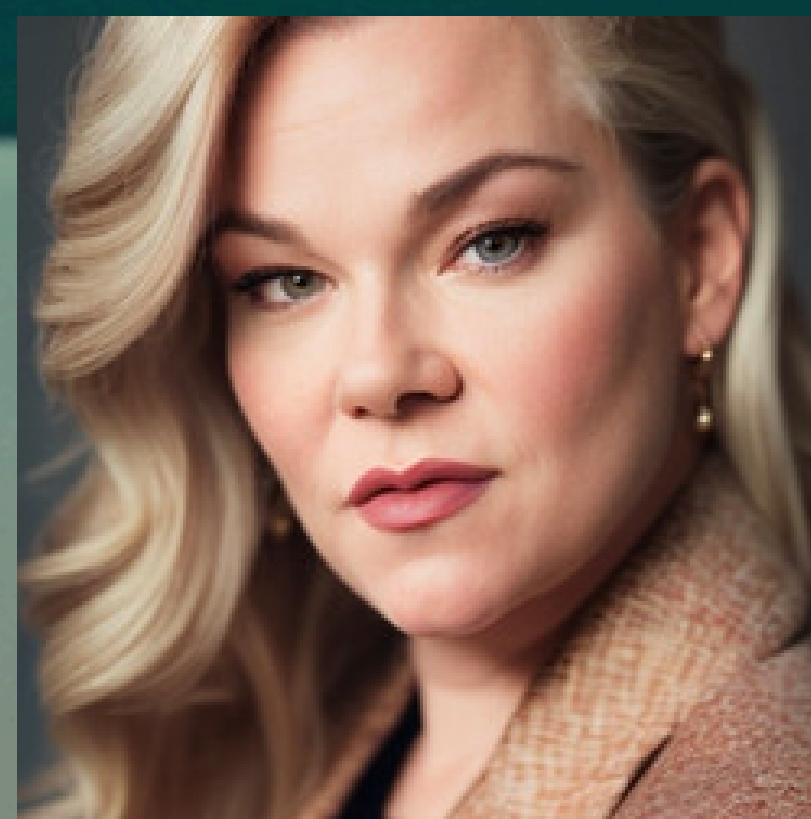

Since the presidential election, counselors and educators have been struggling to reconcile executive orders and legal changes with our professional values and ethics. Some of these orders are being challenged by Governor Shapiro's office leaving things, for the time being, in legal limbo. This interactive ethics lecture will present current information on how these actions are impacting our clients and students in The Commonwealth. In this session, participants will be directed to the specific ethical codes from Counseling and Human Services, Clinical Mental Health, School and Clinical Rehabilitation Counseling specialties that provide an antidote to the current service provision climate.
